Administration

- ▶ The school is now operating a cashless system.

The Curriculum

Language and Literacy:

Reading - Encourage reading at home. Listen to your child reading their 'Home Reads'. Listen for expression, fluency and understanding of the story.

In Class we have- Shared Reading Guided Reading

Writing - Forms of Writing; Narrative, Procedural, Recount, Report, Persuasive and Explanation. (Whole School Focus linked with Assessment)

Mathematics and Numeracy:

Processes, Number, Measures, Shape & Space and Handling Data

The World Around Us - Topics include All About Me, Toys, On the Farm, Under the Sea.

The Arts- music, drama, art through play

ICT- ICT is a cross curricular skill and is developed through all areas of the curriculum. iPads are now used as part of the daily teaching within the school. Seesaw - online activities. Coding - new devices.

- ▶ PE: Wednesday
- Personal Development & Mutual Understanding: We follow the Living Learning Together Programme e.g. develop feelings, identity etc.

Religious Education:

We are following the Grow in Love and the RSE programme Wonder of my Being. The Grow in Love Programme is taught on a rolling basis so children get to experience both the P1/P2 curriculum over the 2 years.

Testing/Assessment

- We use Assessment for Learning to assess and monitor children's progress and learning - observations, independent work, in class assessment, reading records.
- ► The children use Peer & Self-Assessment to provide feedback on their learning.
- Throughout the year we level pieces of children's work using their CCS book.
- Weekly phonics/ tricky words check ups.
- Mental maths check ups.

Homework

- This year we will be using the e-learning platform Seesaw for our main homework.
- Activities will be posted for the week on a Monday at 2pm where possible.
- Reading books will be sent home on a daily basis. They must be returned to the book basket to sit for 72 hours.
- In addition to homework activities posted on Seesaw P2 pupils should also do the following each night:
 - Build phonics words.
 - Read and write tricky words.
 - Orally recall numbers/ write numbers.

- Due to Covid restrictions we can only offer Stay and Play at this time.
