# The Curriculum

Language and Literacy:

- Encourage reading at home - Home Reads, Reading Eggs and Library Book Listen to your child reading their 'Home Reads'. Listen for expression, fluency and understanding of the story.

In Class we have- Shared Reading - Class Reads
Guided Reading - Class Novel

Writing - Forms of Writing; Narrative, Procedural, Recount, Report, Persuasive and Explanation.

#### Mathematics and Numeracy:

Processes, Number, Measures, Shape & Space and Handling Data- Focus Number and problem solving. Please help your child to learn their number bonds/times tables. We have a weekly mental maths check up alongside our spelling check up test.

The World Around Us - Topic- Ireland will be our First Topic.

The Arts- music, drama and art

ICT-ICT is a cross curricular skill and is developed through all areas of the curriculum. iPads are now used as part of the daily teaching within the school and will be used as part of our blended learning, Seesaw, log in details to access MySchool.

PE: Full PE uniform required

A broad range of sports and activities will be covered in PE.

# TESTING/ASSESSMENT

- ▶ We use AfL to assess and monitor children's progress and learning.
- ► The children use Peer & Self-Assessment to provide feedback on their learning. Traffic light system.
- ▶ Progress tests PTE, PTM (May 2024\*)

#### HOMEWORK

- Mental Maths Book- Daily Activity Monday-Thursday (On alternative weeks).
- Spelling workbooks on alternative weeks. 4 pages per unit, one page completed each night. On these weeks, the 'List & Revision' words will be their spellings to learn.
- ► Where appropriate a written piece of Literacy or Numeracy homework may be provided.
- ▶ Spellings & Reading and mental maths focus.
- Reading Eggs and Mathletics- Activities will be assigned weekly and should be completed for a Thursday night. This will be rotated.
- ► All homework should be completed, signed and returned to school daily:
- A weekly overview with instructions for homework will be provided each week in their homework diary.

At present there is no Extended School Clubs available for children in P6/7 as there is no demand for this facility.
